




Degree Programs Designed for the Working Adult

Why earn an MBA?

Job candidates with a Master of Business Administration (MBA) enjoy a wider range of career options and greater earning potential. An MBA degree will prepare you to move forward into a managerial position or equip you with the knowledge and expertise to start your own business.

The Graduate Management Admission Council (GMAC) reported in their 2013 Alumni Perspectives Survey that the median annual salary for MBA degree holders was \$100,000.

Course Sequence for the MBA Lean Emphasis Hybrid:

The Lean Emphasis component of the MBA will be offered in a hybrid, modular format. All five modules will be offered within an 18-month time period. The suggested course sequence is shown below. Because the courses will be offered primarily for individuals working at targeted industries and may need to be aligned with employers' needs and schedules, the specific timing of the modules may change. Modules may vary from three to eight weeks in duration.
